DETER CRIME FROM YOUR PROPERTY

Criminals are always looking for places to hide from watchful eyes. Property that is clean and secure sends a message that someone is watching and will deter criminal activity.

Please use this checklist to keep your property, customers and our community safe. Thank you!

Crime Prevention Checklist:



Remove graffiti and pick up trash as soon as possible



Keep your restrooms locked and reserved for customers only



Secure outside water sources from unwanted use



Secure access to your wifi within your business walls and through the night



Eliminate exterior (or interior) outlets that can attract vagrancy



Lock your dumpsters, gates, doors to keep your property secure

Add bright lights throughout the exterior, and check that lights are all working



Keep trees and shrubbery trimmed up to eliminate hiding spaces



Make repairs to your property as needed to send the message that the property is being regularly managed

Adding on site security that is visible and engaged will keep crime from your property. Sharing this cost with other businesses in the area makes this more affordable.



Add visible cameras throughout your property to deter criminal activity.



Post No Trespassing signs throughout the property and enforce throughout the day



Keep your Authority to Arrest (ATA) updated. This allows officers to arrest individuals on your property after business hours.
